**RULES OF ENTRY**

1. Nominee must be an NDSRT member.
2. Nominees must be notified and voice acceptance of nomination received before their nomination can be submitted.
3. Nomination must be submitted to the NDSRT Board one year in advance of the intended NDSRT state conference.
4. The lecture shall be fifty minutes in length and contain scientific information.
5. If selected, nominee must submit outline, objectives and curriculum vitae to the NDSRT Board by the Third board meeting.
